# **Board of Trustees Votes to Divest from Public Market Holdings** in Private Prisons and Detention Centers

Board Takes Action to Protect Public Safety, Public Service Employees, and the People they Serve

During their August 16, 2018, meeting, the Chicago Teachers' Pension Fund (CTPF) Board of Trustees voted for CTPF to divest and to prohibit future investment in private prison companies and businesses that operate immigration detention centers.

Jay C. Rehak, President of the CTPF Board of Trustees said, "As part of our duty to maintain sound, long-term investments, CTPF has divested from investments in private prisons and privately-run immigrant detention centers that deliberately outsource public services and foster unsafe working and living conditions. We know these institutions disproportionately incarcerate people of color and those who live below the poverty line, house immigrant children and perpetuate the separation of immigrant families, and take advantage of and put at risk unprotected, low-wage employees, while lacking fiscal and operational transparency." Rehak continued, "CTPF continues to be a leader in scrutinizing our investments worldwide. I'm proud of our action, and members should be too."

# **2018 Notice of Trustee Elections**

#### CTPF will hold elections for:

- Two (2) Teacher Trustees to serve three-year terms ending November 2021 (voting November 1-7, 2018)
- One (1) Teacher Trustee to fill a vacancy for a one-year term ending November 2019 (voting November 1-7, 2018)
- One (1) Pensioner Trustee to fill a vacancy for a term ending November 2019 (voting October 19 - November 7, 2018)

Candidates for the Teacher Trustee election may choose to either run for the available one-year seat, or for one of the two available three-year seats.

A candidate may not run for both a one-year and a three-year seat.

# 2018 — Elections

## **Eligibility Criteria for Candidates**

Individuals who wish to run for office must meet the following criteria as of October 1, 2018:

#### **Teacher Trustee candidates must:**

- 1. Be a Member, other than a Principal/Administrator, as defined in 40 ILCS 5/17-106;
- 2. Have been assigned on a regular certificate for at least 10 years in the Chicago Public Schools or Charter schools within District 299 (this includes anyone who is licensed and has worked in the Chicago Public Schools or Charter Schools for at least 10 years on a regular certificate, including as a substitute);
- 3. Be nominated by a petition signed by at least 200 contributors who are not Principals/Administrators, as provided in 40 ILCS 5/17- 139(1); and
- 4. Complete a 2018 Teacher Trustee Election Designation Form

## **Pensioner Trustee candidates must:**

- 1. Be a service, reciprocal, or disability pensioner receiving monthly payments from the Fund; and
- 2. Be nominated by a petition signed by not less than 100 pensioners, as provided in 40 ILCS 5/17-139(2)

#### **Nomination Packets**

Individuals who meet the criteria listed above can request a nomination packet from the Chicago Teachers' Pension Fund. Completed petitions, candidate resumes, and, if applicable, Teacher Trustee Election Designation Forms, must be submitted to the Chicago Teachers' Pension Fund office, 203 North LaSalle Street, Suite 2600, Chicago, Illinois 60601-1231, on or before the close of business at 5:00 p.m. (CT), Monday, October 1, 2018.

# **CTPF Retirees: Important Information on Returning to Work**

After retiring from CPS or a Charter School, a CTPF retiree may decide to return to work on a part- or full-time basis. But there are some rules to be aware of to keep your pension from being jeopardized. A retiree may go to work for any employer that is not the Chicago Board of Education or a Chicago Charter school without restrictions.

Retirees must, however, adhere to post-retirement employment limitations and restrictions if returning to work for the Chicago Board of Education or a Chicago Charter school. Serious financial consequences can occur when limitations are exceeded. You must notify CTPF in writing before beginning employment with the Chicago Board of Education or a Chicago Charter school (Employer).

You must independently track your own days worked. No matter what employer system you use to register for your hours, you are responsible for keeping track of your days worked (such as in a document, spreadsheet, or calendar you maintain). Employers use various systems to register hours worked and those systems are not connected to each other. Therefore, there is no single place you can go to find out how many days you've worked in a year.

You will not receive a warning if you are getting close to the maximum. You are responsible for tracking your days.
