Board of Trustees Active Teacher Trustee Vacancy

On June 15, 2017, Raymond Wohl, a Teacher Trustee, announced his retirement from Chicago Public Schools (CPS) and resignation from the Chicago Teachers' Pension Fund Board of Trustees. The Board of Trustees and Fund staff thanked him for his many years of dedicated service to the Fund and CPS students.

In accordance with the Pension Board Bylaws, the Board declared a vacancy in a Teacher Trustee position. The Vice President of the Board appointed a special committee of three Trustees to evaluate candidates to fill the vacancy and to make a recommendation to the Board on July 20, 2017.



Any **eligible active teacher** may ask to be considered to fill the vacancy. A candidate for the Teacher Trustee position must meet the following eligibility criteria:

- 1. be a Contributor/Member, other than a principal/administrator, of the Fund, as defined in 40 ILCS 5/17-106;
- 2. have been assigned on a regular certificate (license) for at least 10 years in the Chicago Public Schools or charter schools within District 299.

The special committee will meet prior to the next regular Board of Trustees' meeting to review applications and evaluate the candidates.
