The 2024 Open Enrollment Period runs from October 1-31, 2023. During this time, annuitants can enroll, add or drop a dependent, or change a health insurance plan or carrier. Changes become effective January 1, 2024.

The Board of Trustees voted to continue the 60% premium subsidy for 2024.

New in 2024

CTPF will offer the Cigna Surround Group Supplement Plan with Express Scripts Medicare (PDP). This is an insured plan that is modeled after Medicare Plan G. This plan is available to members who are Medicare recipients who turned 65 in 2020 or later.
